SUMMER CLOTHING WORN TO SCHOOL

MONDAY – THURSDAY:

All children should wear comfortable and durable home clothes to school. Please bear in mind that the children will be engaged in activities indoors and active movement activities outdoors during their day at school and their choice of clothing should enable them to do so comfortably.

FRIDAY IS SCHOOL UNIFORM DAY:

All children to wear an Oakview Academy navy blue T-shirt and blue denim fabric bottoms of your choice. For example, a skirt, shorts, longs, Bermuda's or a skort. Children may also wear an Oakview Academy branded hoodie for chilly days.

Summer Hat / Cap - All children to wear an Oakview Academy navy blue hat or cap daily in Summer.

T-shirts / hats / caps / branded hoodie can be purchased through the school.

SUMMER FOOTWEAR

Barefoot is BEST! However, if children do wear footwear in Summer, this should be in the form of easy slip on shoes or flip flops.

NO pumps, shoes with laces, buckles or velcro worn to school please.

WINTER CLOTHING WORN TO SCHOOL

MONDAY – THURSDAY:

All children should wear suitable warm home clothing to school. They are welcome to wear the Oakview Academy branded hoodie or their own long sleeve, plain navy fleece top with school badge attached. Please allow your child to wear a plain navy blue rain jacket if possible (available from Ackermans, Pep, Jet, etc.)

FRIDAY IS SCHOOL UNIFORM DAY:

All children are required to wear an Oakview Academy branded hoodie only, with any warm long sleeve top underneath and plain navy blue long bottoms. For example: jeans, tracksuit pants, corduroy pants. Please wear a plain navy blue rain jacket if possible (available from Ackermans, Pep, Jet, etc.).

PLEASE KINDLY NOTE THAT WE HAVE THE BRANDED OAKVIEW ACADEMY HOODED WINDBREAKER (RAIN JACKET) AVAILABLE FROM SCHOOL. THE SMALLEST SIZE STARTS FROM AGE 5-6.

WINTER FOOTWEAR

Wellington boots (rain boots) must be worn to and from school daily and a pair of bed slippers supplied, which will stay at school during Winter months.

HAIR AND NAILS

- Fringes may not hang in a child's eyes and long hair should be tied up for school.
- Nails must be kept short and clean.

JEWELLERY

- The wearing of jewellery as part of a religious faith practiced by a learner, is allowed. A letter will be required to inform school of this observance.
- No chains, rings or arm bands/bangles allowed.
- 1 pair of plain gold or silver studs may be worn. (No studs with stones or sleeper earrings allowed).

MEDICAL ALERT BRACELETS ARE PERMITTED AT SCHOOL.

SCHOOL BAGS

- You may use a school bag of your choice.
- The bag should be big enough to hold a set of spare clothing, lunch box and school daily diary.
